The following comments are taken from a letter dated April 23, 1996 from Richard & Margaret Shadick. A copy of the letter is provided in Appendix 1.

1. Comment:

Our house is located 81 feet West of Lishakill Rd. We are very concerned with the proposal to construct a roadway which would exist on our neighbors' land. We will never allow this to happen, because there are other viable solutions which would not only save people's homes but would also save the town money.

One such proposal I recommended at the town meeting was to construct the roadway along the tracks and bring it out either where the old train station is or down further where the other warehouses are. There is already an access road leading into the train station that would just need some repaving. By putting a road there, you would not be involving homeowners and creating havoc. If you go ahead and construct the road to connect with Lishakill Rd., you will create more traffic and cause more accidents than we already have and believe us, we have all had enough of trucks and cars using Albany St. as a route home where they can avoid all the traffic lights on Central Avenue.
