1. Laguna Mobil CarWash-610 Troy Schenectady Rd. Waiver given for less than 35% green space. Mitigation fee of \$15,900. Much of the green space was taken by the State in the expansion of Route 7.
2. Meadowdale Estates-297 Old Niskayuna Rd. Public hearing not scheduled –Change in building plans. Public hearing to be scheduled in the future.
3. Life Covenant Church- Plans must be resubmitted with accurate information.

Site plans reviewed- Albany RV: Postponed- Fast Track Café- 1167 Troy Schenectady Road- No issues.

A meeting is to be set up with the Supervisor to discuss the issue of the Emerald Ash Borer. Colonie has an area which has been designated by the DEC as a hotspot. How will the town respond to the issue.
